1. God identifies himself as the  
compassionate one.

*And he passed in front of Moses, proclaiming,  
“The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and  
gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love  
and faithfulness.” (Ex. 34:6)*

*In bringing many sons to glory, it was fitting that God, for whom and through whom everything exists, should make the author of their salvation perfect through suffering. (Heb. 2:10)*

*... When he saw the crowds, he had compassion for them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. (Matt. 9:35-36)*
